"... Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

8 And there followed another angel, saying, **Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.**

9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, **If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive [his] mark in his forehead, or in his hand, 10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: 11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name."**

"... Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

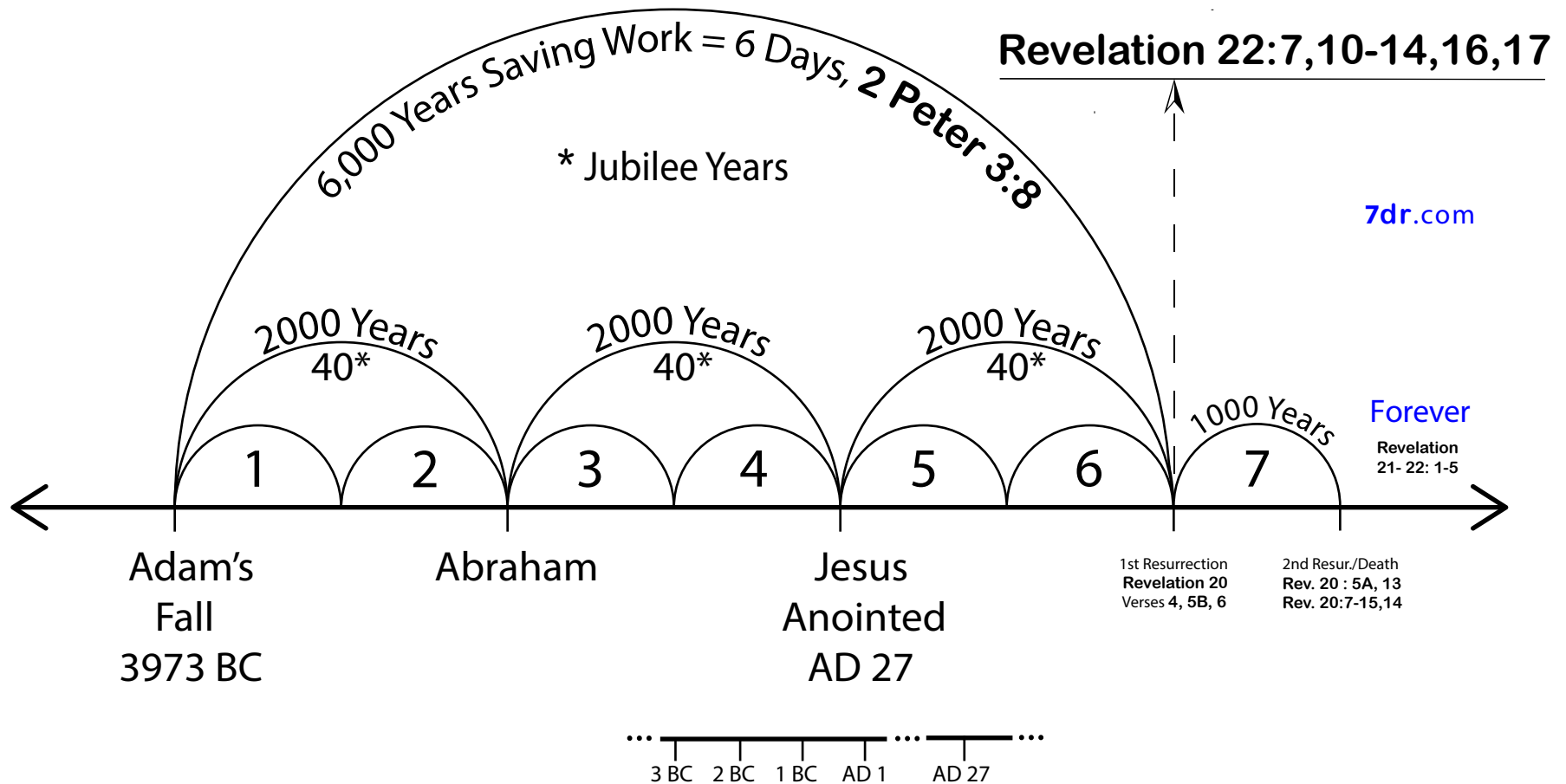
3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies. 4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying,

Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

5 For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities... 7 How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow. 8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong [is] the Lord God who judgeth her."

- A. Jesus was born around Fall of 4-3 BC and then anointed/baptized at 30 years of age, **Luke 3:23**. Note that there are no year 0 in the calendar. So that 1 BC was immediately followed by AD 1.
- B. God teaches His view of days and years: 6 days/years work, then a 7th day/year rest, and a Jubilee. **Genesis 1** and **2:1-4**; **Exodus 20:8-11**; **Exodus 21:2**; and **Leviticus 25**.
- C. A jubilee is the year following $7 \times 7 = 49$ years, **Leviticus 25: 8, 10**. The 50th year is called a Jubilee (redemption/liberty). Therefore 2,000 years = 50 years per jubilee \times 40 Jubilees, and 6,000 = 50 \times 120 Jubilees, "... yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years." **Genesis 6:3**
